Dear Mr. Pulley:

The Last Bastion Station Trust, LLC, as Trustee (“*LBST*” or “*Licensee*”), licensee of broadcast station KINB(FM), Kingfisher, Oklahoma, Facility ID No. 88376 (“*KINB*” or “*Station*”), hereby submits the information concerning the Station’s EEO program requested by the Federal Communications Commission (“*Commission*”) in its letter dated June 7, 2012 from the Media Bureau to the Station (“*EEO Audit Letter*”). The responses below correspond to the numbered paragraphs as set forth in the EEO Audit Letter.

Paragraph 2.

KINB has fewer than five full-time employees, and is not, therefore, required by FCC policies to have a formal EEO recruitment program. On June 12, 2007, the assignment of KINB from Citadel Broadcasting Company (“*Citadel*”) to LBST was consummated (FCC File No. BALH-20060228ACE). On September 16, 2011, the transfer of control of Citadel Broadcasting Corporation to Cumulus Media, Inc. (“*Cumulus*”) was consummated (FCC File No. BTC-20110330ADE) (the “*Cumulus/Citadel Merger*”). As a result of the Cumulus/Citadel Merger, the beneficiary of the Citadel Divestiture Trust is now Cumulus. Pursuant to the underlying trust agreement and a related Facilities and Services Agreement between the parties, the Station continues to share employees with Cumulus’ employment unit in the Oklahoma City, Oklahoma market; accordingly, the Licensee has no full-time employees.

To LBST's knowledge, during the current license term of KINB, there have been no complaints resolved against the Licensee, and there are no pending complaints filed before any legal or governmental body alleging unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex with respect to the employment practices of the Licensee.

Paragraph 4:


The Station is not presently subject to a time brokerage agreement.
